There are a variety of ways to show your ministry is active and engaged, many that could easily "piggy-back" on other events in the church or community. Brainstorm creative ways to highlight your ministry to inactive women in your church. The following are ideas you might consider trying.

Plan humorous skits for Sunday morning announcements or other church events to invite women and girls into the ministry.



→ Hand out flowers or another small token gift to women and girls following church on Sunday, with a tag attached promoting your women's and girls' ministries.

The Create business cards for the ministry with the name of the ministry, regular meeting times and location, a line from scripture or a

tagline that aptly describes the main focus of the ministry, and contact information. Be sure everyone in the ministry has several cards and encourage them to hand these cards out when they meet women they think may benefit from engagement in your ministry.
