


2023 Goal -\$100,000

Happy New Year!! As many local and association ABW's will be starting the new year with new officers, including Love Gift Coordinators, I thought it was a good time to once again share some of the "Story of Love Gift."

When Love Gift was set up many years ago, it was devoted to the support of the WHOLE mission program. In keeping with this decision, the donations are part of the United Mission program. They are used to support the work represented in the total budget of the American Baptist Churches/USA including the work of overseas missions, home missions, education, state conventions, city missions and general program and administration. There is a legally binding agreement between ABC/USA and the West Virginia Baptist Convention (WVBC) and it can't be altered in any way.

Any money that comes into the WVBC designated "Love Gift" is used in this way: 54.4% of your Love Gift Offering is retained by the WVBC State Office. The remainder is sent to the American Baptist Churches/USA for disbursement as follows: the National Office of American Baptist Women's Ministries receives 15%; Ministry Organizations (global and national) receive 7.65%; and American Baptist Churches USA (which is National Support) keeps 22.95%. (So, if you haven't already taken National Support out of your local budget, please do so. You are supporting that through Love Gift.)



Remember, the Love Gift collected at meetings goes through your church treasurer and is sent to the state office. Keep a record and send a report to your association Coordinator of Love Gift.

As I've promoted, "Love Gift is the Heart of WV ABWM" and has been for many years. My hope is each ABW Ministries group will decide to give from the heart using Love Gift boxes, "L" dollars and involving the whole church in sharing blessings.

As I write this, the last report I've received from the WVBC at the end of October is \$56,915.60. Though short of our goal, hopefully we'll get closer by end of the year. The goal for 2023 is once again \$100,000, and I have faith in the American Baptist women in WV that this is an attainable goal.

Adopt a Seminary Student Program Palmer Theological Seminary Latino Master of Theological Studies


Adopted Student: Aracelys Camejo (a-ra-CELL-ees ca-MAY-ho)

Status: Single with no children



Through Global Servant J. D. Reed, the West Virginia Baptist Convention and International Ministries, the WV ABWM Board voted at the November 2021 meeting to adopt two female Latino seminary students. Until recently they were anonymous to us but now we have photos and identifications for our two students. Through sponsorship you are paying the annual tuition of \$2,400 for each student for two years. Funding sources include the Million Women Movement fund and the Mountain State Mission Offering fund.

Your scholarship gifts to these girls will train them so that they can effectively lead a church and teach others how to join them in God's work. This program will have an impact for generations in the regions in which they live and teach.
